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- Acquire imagery every 5 years (Census-year and mid-decade)
- Driven by metro-wide generalized Land Use data collection
- State of MN Imagery Master Purchase Agreement work order
- Kucera International
- Project Area: 268 USGS Quarter Quadrangles intersecting the 7-county metro
- Spring, leaf-off, snow-free, ice-out, cloud-free, smoke-free, flood-free
- Sun angle greater than 30° above the horizon
- 30 cm resolution (1 ft)
- Overlap 30% minimum, 40% developed area and 60% downtowns
 - Flightlines oriented to major streets for both downtowns.
- Horizontal accuracy
 - ASPRS horizontal accuracy standard for ground sampling distance of 30-cm at Standard Mapping Accuracy of 60-cm
 - Source DEM
 - 2022 USGS QL1 lidar DEM (MN GAC 3D Geomatics Committee)
- Partners
 - MNIT Geospatial Information Office
 - MnDOT Survey and Mapping
 - Deliverables
 - Uncompressed GeoTIFFs
 - Compressed County Mosaics in JPEG 2000
- Publicly available on the MnGeo Image Server

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




6) Metro Food Resources Map update (pilot)


